### **Part-time and Casual Drivers**

The successful candidates will have passenger transportation experience and strong customer service and interpersonal skills. Applicants must possess a Public Passenger Vehicle Ancillary Certificate and Light Rigid Driver's Licence.

These part -time positions will support existing schedules and drivers operating light buses in the Derwent Valley, Central Highlands, Midlands, Southern Midlands and Hobart with early morning, afternoon and split shifts required. A minimum of 6 – 12 hours per week are available with other shifts highly likely on a regular basis. Good prospects exist for the right candidate for long term regular shifts on new schedules as the service expands.

The position is classified at Level 3 of the Passenger Vehicle Transport Award 2010 with an hourly rate of \$22.77 per hour, including leave entitlements and the benefits salary sacrifice options or \$28.46 for casual positions.
