## Adult Concession and Tertiary Student Fare

The following Government Concession cards entitle the holder to the Adult Concession Fares below:

- Age Pension Card
- Vision Impaired Travel Pass
- Veteran Affairs Card
- Health Care Card – New Start, Youth Allowance or Widows Allowance

Full time students aged 19 years and over are eligible for a tertiary student fare, which is the standard adult concession fare. Students are required to be in full time education, attending:

- TasTAFE
- University
- Australian Maritime College
- Australian Technical College
- Senior Secondary College

All cards must be presented and carried throughout the journey

## Child and Student Fare

Children travelling with an adult under the age of four who do not occupy a seat travel for free.

Children under 16 years of age are eligible to travel at child/student fares as published by the Department of State Growth which is currently **\$1.80 (regardless of origin, destination and distance travelled)**.

Full time Senior Secondary Students, Australian Technical College, University, and TasTAFE students are eligible for the child/student concession fare up to and including the school year in which they turn 18 years of age. A student must present their student identification card to purchase a child/student fare when requested
